The programme consists of modules each worth a specific number of credits. A student completes their programme by passing and accumulating credits in line with the requirements of the programme. 1 credit represents 10 notional or estimated learning hours; thus, a module of 10 credits will typically require about 100 hours of learning during the semester. The estimated learning hours include both guided and independent study time.

The University normally limits the credits that a student can register for to 60 credits for semesters longer than 5 months and to 24 credits for shorter semesters; this is done to ensure that students do not take a load that they cannot manage. Students wishing to study extra credits will need to apply to the Faculty Dean and may be allowed based on past

performance and other considerations in line with the Student Handbook/Regulations. The University recommends that part-time students (those who have other full-time responsibilities) register for no more than 40 credits per semester. The credit value of a module can be known from the Botho University prospectus or website.

Your fee is charged and fully due at the start of the semester; however, the University provides flexible payment terms - you may pay the fee in instalments of per month at the start of the semester and on the first of every following month until the semester fees are fully settled. Delay in paying the monthly instalment may result in being dropped out of the programme. Please note that the fees for a semester must be fully cleared before proceeding to the next semester.

While making payments, please provide your student registration number and name as reference. If proper reference details are provided as required, payments should reflect on your ledger within one week (except during public holidays). You are strongly advised to regularly check your student ledger detail through the student portal to ensure that any payments made are reflected correctly. Should any payment be missing, you must inform your programme mentor immediately.
